Job Purpose: To render a plumber duty at the water and sewer section in the Worcester or De Doorns area. Candidates must resume duty within the Breede Valley Municipal Area, based on the discretion of the Department, in terms of operational requirements.

Duties: Ensure an effective water supply in the Worcester, De Doorns area; Ensure that water usage can be charged to consumers; Ensure an effective sewer system in BVM area; Ensure that consumers are correctly charged for water consumption; Ensure an well maintained plumbing service in the BVM area; Ensure effective watery delivery system to new consumers; Ensure work is carried out as scheduled, that objectives are met and proper outcomes achieved; Maintain and supervise Water & Sewer Network and Bulk Services in respective towns.
