Touws River, famous for its wide-open spaces and clean, champagne air, is the gateway town to the Western Cape's Breede Valley. The town is situated in the Great Karoo alongside the N1, 180km by road from Cape Town and 257km by rail. Touws River is also home to the Venus Astrology site established in 1882. A national monument was erected to commemorate the transit of Venus. Among the attractions offered are a Big Five game reserve, nature reserves, 4x4 trials, Bushman paintings and birding spots.
