Kindly receive addendum no. 1 of the above mentioned tender, to clarify and highlight corrections that were proposed during the clarification meeting that took place on 19 January 2022.

The following points are corrected in the bid document:

1. Location of the tender box:

The correct location of tender boxes is:

Breedevale Valley Credit Control Offices 53 Baring Street, Worcester. The bid box (outside the office – green tender box) is generally open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

2. Functionality:

- (i) The correct total for functionality on page 56 must be 70 and not 65, comprising of sub-elements as follows:

b)	Track record and previous experience of service provider	20
c)	Previous relevant projects of similar nature and extent in a Municipal sphere	20
d)	Who have access to individuals who achieved a National Certificate in the field of close protection (VIP	10


On page 57, the first and the second table are a duplication, hence one of the them must be removed.

- (iii) Criteria (b) on page 57: Bidders are welcome to provide proof of security projects that were undertaken in the past (current and completed) even if those projects were rendered in other organizations which are not municipalities. Scoring model and minim points remain the same.
- (ii) The requirement for criteria (c) on page 58 remains unchanged. Points will only be allocated to service providers who provide proof of having rendered security services to municipalities. Attached to this addendum is the corrected functionality and is labelled as **“Corrected Functionality Scoring”**. **This document must be appended to the original bid document together with the addendum**

3. New closing date of tenders

The extension of the closing date is hereby granted to Friday 4 February 2022, to afford all bidders ample time to take into account the corrections made in the bid document.
