- ✓ Death certificate if spouse/ parents are deceased
- ✓ Declaration from department of labour or SAPS affidavit in case of unemployment
- ✓ Proof of income of ALL adults over 18 in the household
- ✓ Allpay slip or 3 months' bank statements if you get paid into your bank.
